

A factory is a production facility that unites a large number of different work processes and manufactures products with the help of machines and production employees.



Depending on the type of vessel, the capacity of inland waterway vessels varies between 1,000 net tonnes (single vessel) up to 7,000 net tonnes (pusher unit = motorised freight vessel with four motive-less barges) -> High mass capacity



Inland waterway vessels only move in the waterway network. This usually means that transhipment and another transport from the port to the destination is required.
